

## ITU and WASC Public Statement

ITU entered into a settlement agreement with WASC on December 6, 2023. In this agreement, signed by WSCUC President Jamiene Studley and ITU President Yau-Gene Chan, a joint public statement was negotiated as follows:

### Revised ITU Public Statement

ITU is pleased to announce that, on December 8<sup>th</sup> 2023, the WASC Senior College and University Commission (“WSCUC”) vacated its previous withdrawal of ITU’s accreditation and will consider its previously issued Order to Show Cause at its June 2024 meeting. ITU remains accredited and will be afforded the opportunity to meet with a WSCUC team in the spring to highlight the improvements the University has made and discuss its strategic plans for further strengthening and expanding ITU in the future.

ITU’s President Yau-Gene Chan stated: “We are thrilled that WSCUC has revoked its withdrawal of ITU’s accreditation. We are proud to emphasize that ITU’s academic programs remain cutting edge industry-relevant, propelling the majority of ITU’s students to find job placement in Silicon Valley’s top technology companies while still attending ITU classes before matriculation. As always, we continue to stand behind ITU’s educational quality and its high value to our students’ employment and future growth.”

WSCUC President Jamiene S. Studley said, “The Commission looks forward to the opportunities of the Special Visit and June 2024 Commission meeting to learn more about developments at the institution.”
